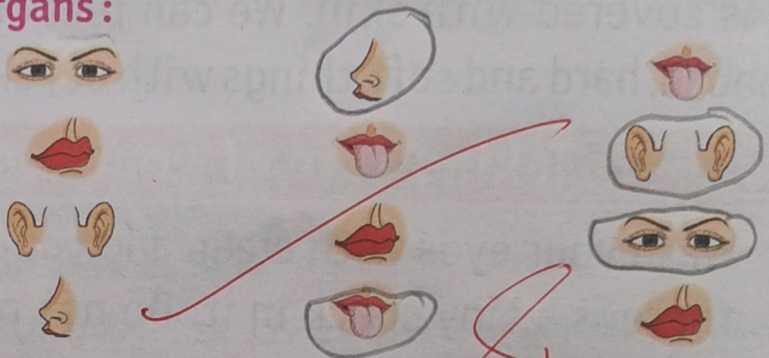

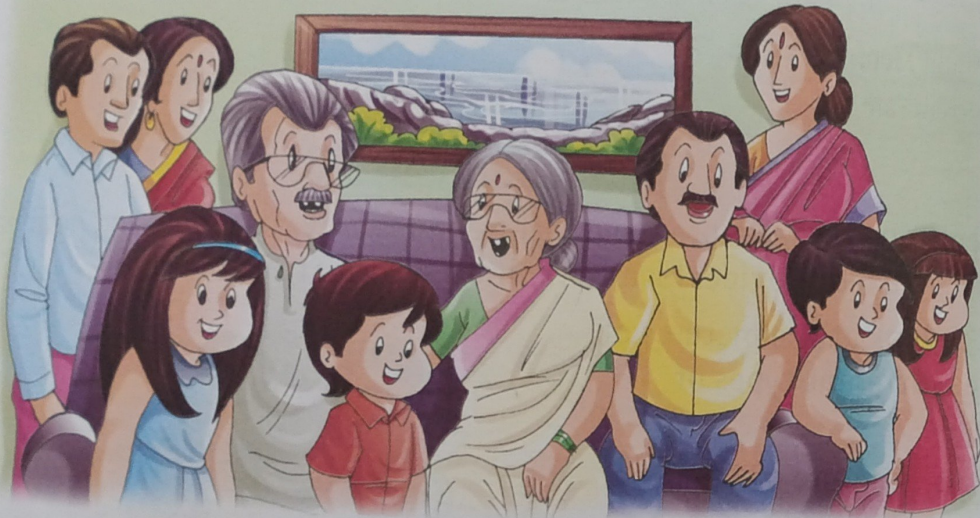
A-1 A family having one set of parents and their children.

This kind of family is known as a joint family. A **joint family** has more than one set of parents and their children. Harshita has a joint family.



A Joint Family

RELATIONS

- Grandfather — father's or mother's father.
- Grandmother — father's or mother's mother.
- Uncle — father's or mother's brother.
- Aunt — wife of father's brother or mother's brother.
— also father's or mother's sister.
- Cousin — children of aunt and uncle.

Key Fact

- A cousin can be a boy or a girl.

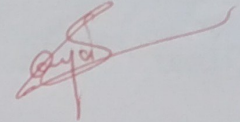
